

Chickens

Supplies:

- G (4.25mm) hook
- Worsted weight (#4) yarn – 2 colors
- Worsted weight (#4) Red yarn
- Orange #10 thread
- 2 – 6mm sequins
- 2 – 6 mm googly eyes
- Plastic egg
- Hot glue



Body:

With color A:

Rnd 1: Ch 26, join with sl st.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, 1 dc in back hump of each ch around; with color B – join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg. Ch 3 (color change made)

Rnd 3: ch 3, dc in next 11 sts, (2 dc in next st) twice; dc in next 12 sts; with color A – join with sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 3 (color change made)

Rnd 4: ch 3, dc in next 9 sts; hdc in next st, sc in next 6 sts, hdc in next st, dc in next 10 sts; sl st in 3rd ch of beg ch 3

Seam Top:

Rnd 5: working across top of last dc row – line up 2nd and 27th dc posts holding sides together – sc through back loops of each st; continue working in back loops of next 7 sts; insert hook through back loops of next sts, yo pull through loops – with color B – yo and pull through both loops (color change made); leave a 2" tail of color A – cut thread

Make Head:

Rnd 6: work in back loops of next 8 sts as follows – dc, trc, trc, dc, dc, trc, trc, dc; leave a 2" tail – cut thread

Crest:

Rnd 7: with red yarn – sl st through back loops of 1st and last dc of Rnd 6, ch 2; 2 dc in back loops of next opposing trc; 2 trc in next opposing trc; dc, hdc in next opposing dc; leave 2" tail cut thread, pull to under side through next st.

Pull tails of colors A & B through to underside of chicken. Work in ends on underside.

Beak:

With orange thread make a slip knot about 2" up from end; ch 2, hdc in 2nd ch from hook; dc in same st; leave about 2" and cut thread. Attach beak at bottom of 2 center dc's on Rnd 6; secure threads by tying a knot and working in excess thread.

Glue sequins on each side of head just above beak, glue googly eyes on top of sequins.

Add a pom pom to back end – or not.
Snug a plastic egg inside of chicken!

THREAD CHICKEN

2 colors of #10 thread
3 (2.10 mm) hook
Red #10 thread
Orange #10 thread
2 – 4mm sequins
2- 4mm googly eyes
Hot glue
Small oval shaped chocolate eggs (I use Butterfinger eggs – yum!)

Follow same pattern as above through Rnd 7.

Beak:

With orange thread, make a slip knot 1.5" up from end – ch 2, hdc in 2nd ch from hook; cut thread about 1.5" from st. Attach to head in same fashion as above.

Complete the chicken with sequin googly eyes.

Stuff with chocolate egg!

This little guy takes some maneuvering but is so cute when you get him done!

Options:

Instead of color changes of thread use a variegated thread for the body. Use different colors for the crest too – *have fun!*
